

Public Hearing on Town of Onalaska 2012 Budget
December 8, 2011

Town Chairman Rolly Bogert called the public hearing to order at 7:00 PM at the Town Hall, W7052 Second Street, Onalaska, WI. Present were Supervisors Rolly Bogert, Steve Michaels, Marc Schultz, Frank Fogel and Sandy Thompson; Clerk Melissa Erdman.

Nineteen Town Residents were present. Copies of the 2012 proposed budget were available. There was a .4% increase in the Town Levy due to growth in the town.

Citizens Comments on Budget

Tammy Addleman, N6681 County Road M, Holmen asked about the Boards decision to not provide donations to the YMCA. It was explained that because of the WI state statutes 60.10(3)(b) & 60.23(3) the Town was not able to donate funds. The board could enter into contracts for services though.

Nancy Way, W7809 County Road ZB, Onalaska asked if services such as transportation to the YMCA could be an option.

Dan Filzen, N5444 Eagle Circle Lane, Onalaska questioned what was cut in the culture, park and rec category. This was the donations.

Supervisor Thompson made a motion to adjourn. Supervisor Michaels seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously at 7:27pm.
