Discussion on the towns conditional use permits, the storm water fees and how they need to be handled. Reibel made a motion to recommend to the board reviewing the storm water ordinance and to charge the fees accordingly. Shefelbine seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Discussion on the deferment of storm water fees to the old ATK site for Dynamic Recycling. Miles Harter present. Reibel made a motion to recommend to the board the deferment of the storm water bill for 10 years. Shefelbine seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Discussion on sending out the 2015 storm water invoices. Reibel made a motion to recommend to the board sending out the invoices on Jan 1, per the storm water ordinance, bills should include information explaining what storm water is, the changes to implementing late charge collection to 1 invoice a year and delinquent charges go on the tax bill. Shefelbine seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
