

Town of Onalaska
Town Board Meeting Minutes
November 11, 2014

Chairman Rolly Bogert called the Town Board Meeting to order on Tuesday, November 11, 2014 at 6:30 pm at the Town of Onalaska Town Hall, N5589 Commerce Road, Onalaska, WI. Supervisors present were Rolly Bogert, Frank Fogel, Stan Hauser and Steve Michaels. Sandy Thompson was excused. Clerk Melissa Erdman also present. The pledge of allegiance was recited.

Supervisor Michaels made a motion to approve the agenda. Supervisor Fogel seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Supervisor Fogel made a motion to approve the October 14, 2014 and October 21, 2014 town board meeting minutes. Supervisor Hauser seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Supervisor Hauser made a motion to approve the bills and finance book. Supervisor Michaels seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Discussion on additional dog request for Jessica Schaffer and Kathryn Spooner, N6124 Apple Valley Road, Onalaska. Kathryn Spooner present. Supervisor Michaels made a motion to approve the request. Supervisor Hauser seconded the motion. Motion passed unananimously.

Discussion on additional dog request for Jennfier lynons, W6428 Hossfeld Road, Holmen. Building a team of dogs for sledding. Jennifer Lyons present. Melissa Erdman spoke in favor of the request. Supervisor Hauser made a motion to approve 2 additional dogs for a total of 7 with the authority to pull the permit if neighbors complain. Supervisor Michaels seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Discussion on deferment of personal property for Dynamic Recycling. Per our attorney, cannot offer. No action.

Discussion on rescinding motion on assessing fees for delinquent storm water bills. Supervisor Fogel made a motion to rescind the previous motion of assessing a \$15 late fee and to follow town ordinance. Supervisor Hauser seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Discussion on temporary plates for Johnson and Sweden Coulee Bridges. Supervisor Hauser made a motion to no purchase the temporary plates. Supervisor Fogel seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Storm Water

Discussion on culvert issues on Apple Blossom Trail. Supervisor Fogel made a motion to repost for bid. Supervisor Hauser seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Discussion on informational flyer for storm water billing. Supervisor Michaels made a motion to add improve the logo, add Nicos name and extension, remove how to dispute, print in black and white, tri fold inhouse and order self adhesive envelopes. Supervisor Hauser seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Discussion on Greyhawk pond waterway entrance. Supervisor Fogel made a motion to put out for bid for this spring. Supervisor Michaels seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Discussion on Town and Storm water split of responsibilities. Supervisor Hauser made a motion to approve the responsibility split as presented. Supervisor Michaels seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Discussion on storm water budget. Supervisor Fogel made a motion to research where the money is from and for storm water to distribute the money in restricted reserves for reserve equity and projects. Supervisor Hauser seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Correspondence

Rolly states the town planner is to meet with Village of Holmen. The incorporation has been filled with the courts. Rolly met with General Engineering while at the Towns Association.

Steve recommended that the Fire board should consider meeting monthly.

Supervisor Hauser made a motion to adjourn. Second by Supervisor Michaels. Motion passed unanimously at 7:45 PM.
