TOWN OF ONALASKA  
PLAN COMMISSION MEETING  
March 13, 2017

The regular meeting of the Town of Onalaska Plan Commission was called to order at 7:00 pm by Chairman Rolly Bogert at the Town of Onalaska Town Hall, N5589 Commerce Road, Onalaska, WI. Members present; Rolly Bogert, Frank Fogel, Gerald Monti, Charlie Lipke, Doug Shefelbine and Tom Thompson. Mary Rinehart was also present.

A motion was made by Monti, seconded by Lipke to approve the agenda. Motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Monti, seconded by Fogel to approve the minutes of the February 13, 2017 meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

Discussion on Conditional Use Permit for Franks Repair, N6263 County Road ZB, tax parcel 10-1560-4: Fogel abstained from participation due to a conflict of interest and left the board table. Kirby Pabst, of Pabst Engineering presented on behalf of Fogel. Motion by Monti; seconded by Shefelbine to recommend approval upon compliance with the requirements for inspection outlined in a letter from Holmen Area Fire Department. Motion passed 5-0 (Fogel abstained).

Dynamic Recycling presentation for information on the proposed amendment to the comprehensive plan: Miles Harter of Dynamic Recycling, using a power point format, presented the Dynamic expansion plan in relation to Town Comprehensive Plan and proposed changes. Harter addressed questions from the floor and the commission members. Copy of the materials was filed with the clerk.

Discussion on Resolution recommending amendments to the Comprehensive Plan of the Town of Onalaska: A copy of the proposed amendments and resolution was available for viewing and will remain available for public viewing in the clerk's office. Public hearing date is April 11, 2017 at 5:30 pm in the Town Hall board room. Motion by Thompson; seconded by Monti to recommend approval of Plan Commission resolution 2017-03-13 recommending amendments to the comprehensive plan of the Town of Onalaska. Motion passed unanimously.
