Storm Water Utility District Meeting
August 1, 2017

The Storm Water Utility District Meeting was called to order by Chairman Rolly Bogert at 6:00 pm at the Town of Onalaska Town Hall, N5589 Commerce Road, Onalaska, WI. Members present: Rolly Bogert, Marc Schultz and Dan Hanson. Dale Shefelbine was absent, and Stan Hauser was excused. Town Clerk, Mary Rinehart was also present.

Hanson made a motion to approve the agenda; Schultz seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Schultz; seconded by Hanson to approve the minutes of the July 5, 2017 meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion to approve the bills and finance book by Schultz; seconded by Hanson, passed unanimously.

Public Comment: Cheryl Thienes W6485 Schilling Road, Onalaska addressed the utility regarding damages in the Apple Valley occurring during the July 19 and 20, 2017 storm event as well as drainage concerns prior to that event.

Damage report of July 19 and 20, 2017 storm event: The cumulative town wide damage list was reviewed.

Discussion on W6490 Schilling Road drainage and storm water retention issues: Motion open the floor by Schultz; seconded by Hanson passed unanimously. Julie Frawley of W6490 Schilling Road spoke in regarding concerns of drainage onto and through her property, what Town assistance may be available, and what the Town responsibility is in regards to making repairs. Motion to close the floor by Schultz; seconded by Hanson passed unanimously.

Motion by Schultz; seconded by Hanson to recommend to Apple Valley land/property owners collectively to work with La Crosse County Land Conservation and for the Town to work with La Crosse County Land Conservation. Motion passed unanimously. Schultz also suggested a join meeting with La Crosse County Land Conservation, Natural Resources Conservation Services (NRCS) and Farm Service Agency (FSA).

Motion to adjourn by Hanson; seconded by Schultz passed unanimously at 7:27 PM
