Discussion on making recommendation to the Town Board regarding implementation of a residential refuse fee equal to the per household cost of the service and be billed yearly on property tax bills.

Motion passed unanimously.

Discussion on making recommendation to the Town Board regarding the hosting of a white goods and appliance recycling drive in 2019 in conjunction with Dynamic Recycling.

Committee member Schultz abstained from discussion due to employment conflict of interest. Clerk Rinehart described discussions she's had with vendors to coordinate a white goods/appliance recycling drive for Town residents. Motion by Storandt; seconded by Kessler to recommend to the Town Board that the Town would host a white goods and appliance recycling drive in 2019 in conjunction with Dynamic Recycling. Motion passed: Burch, Fogel, Hauser, Kessler, Storandt, Wage: aye, Schultz abstained.
