Town of Onalaska Stormwater Utility District Meeting
March 29, 2011

Chairman Dave Paudler called the Stormwater Management Utility Meeting to order at 6:30 pm on Tuesday, March 29, 2011 at the Town Hall, W7052 Second Street, Onalaska. Members present included: Chairman Paudler, Supervisors Frank Fogel, Steve Michaels, Marc Schultz and Sandy Thompson. Clerk Sue Schultz and Joe Dorava, Town Engineer, Vierbicher Associates were present.

Supervisor Schultz motioned to approve the agenda.
Supervisor Thompson seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Supervisor Michaels motioned to approve the February 22, 2011 minutes.
Supervisor Thompson seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously

Joe Dorava gave the Annual Storm Water Permit Report, The report was emailed to Board Members to review prior to the meeting.
Supervisor Thompson motioned to approve the 2010 Annual Storm Water Permit Report.
Supervisor Schultz seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Dorava reported on stormwater concerns he has checked on.
The washout at N6031 Apple Valley Road (Joann McLees). The Town Crew is aware of this. A culvert needs to be replaced—need a larger one—maybe 60 foot. The owner put in too small of a culvert. Swall has filled in and now needs cleaning out.

Tim Carrier, W5835 Koss Road has water on his road. There is no culvert there. Need to look at area again once the snow melts.

Thunderbird Heights concern. There needs to be a plan for repair as drainage channel has filled in. The East Drainage is the concern and it is near the boundary with the Village of Holmen.

Reef and Sand Piper (Across from Thunderbird Park): survey of area to divert water off the road. Will view again once the snow melts.

Penney Lane—needs to find out where the property line is as may need an easement from the landowners to do work.

Citizen Concerns:

Tim Carrier, W5835 Koss Road, Onalaska, spoke that the road has been resurfaced and the road is higher than his property. That is what creates a water problem. Mr. Dorava will look at this.

Board Member Concerns:

Can the Stormwater Utility Budget cover these corrections such as culvert replacement. Answer is yes.

Supervisor Schultz asked about the Wisconsin Budget Legislation on Stormwater Mandates. Will the Stormwater regulations be eliminated or reduce the 40% reduction of sediment now required? There is no definite answer now.

The Stormwater Ordinances need to be placed on the web.

Supervisor Thompson made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:45 pm.
Supervisor Michaels seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously
