Storm Water Utility District Meeting

Chairman Rolly Bogert called the Storm Water Utility District Meeting to order at 6:00 pm on Tuesday September 2, 2014 at the Town of Onalaska Town Hall, N5589 Commerce Road, Onalaska, WI. Members present included: Rolly Bogert, Bill Reibel, Dale Shefelbine, Tim Carrier and Marc Schultz. Deputy-Clerk Mary Rinehart, Nikolaus Stoufis and K Don Pederson were also present.

Schultz made a motion to approve the agenda, Reibel seconded the motion. MPU

Reibel made a motion to approve the August 5, 2014 meeting minutes. Shefelbine seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Discussion on the finance book followed. Schultz made a motion to postpone to after budget discussion as he had questions regarding the breakdown of administrative expenses. Reibel seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Discussion on Don Pedersons River Rock Condo property. Don Pederson, 313 S 13<sup>th</sup> Street, Onalaska gave a brief history of the project and his issues of concern. Schultz made a motion to ask the town board to request a meeting of the principals involved including Storm Water Committee, La Crosse County Erosion Control, La Crosse County Zoning, and La Crosse Engineering, and that in the interim no additional building to proceed, seconded by Reibel. Motion passed unanimously. Pederson is to provide documentation of original condo documents.

Discussion on storm water bill informational flyer. Carrier had list of questions he would like to have in the flyer. 1). What is Storm water utility? 2). How much are you billed? 3). What is the money used for? 4). Is this tax deductible? 5). Can this be added to other town bills? Committee requested storm water employee to work up a newer version of flyer for next meeting to include Mr. Carriers' list.

Discussion on 2015 budget. No action. Bogert and Reibel will continue to work on subcategories.

Discussion on finance book. Motion to approve bills and finance with additional breakdown on administration charges both now and monthly and going forward. Reibel seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
